The 2020 Marienburg GG Fahrlay is another fascinating, intense, clear and precise, bright, shining and utterly Mosel-styled Riesling from the blue slate terroir of the Fahrlay parcel that hosts vines that are older than 75 years. The wine reveals remarkable finesse and elegance on the palate and develops a long, refined and salty finish that is less challenging, dramatic and tannic than that of the Rothenpfad and the Marienburg, but it's fabulous in its finesse and elegance. Weightless but long and salty. Tasted in Wiesbaden in August 2021.

The 2020 Marienburg GG Rothenpfad offers a pure yet intense and refined bouquet of crushed slate, lemons and herbs. Still discreet but already complex, this is a filigreed but intense and juicy Rothenpfad with concentrated fruit, fine tannins and a long and intense finish. Not as pure, precise and filigreed as the Marienburg, but it is a late starter with excellent aging potential. Tasted in Wiesbaden in August 2021.

From an extremely effortful vintage, Busch's 2020 Marienburg GG is pure, very intense and mineral on the simply spectacular deep, precise and terroir-driven nose. I had this wine in a blind tasting of 100 top 2020 Rieslings some days before, and it was one of my absolute favorites, and here it is shining again. The wine is enormously salty and complex, tightly woven but never too powerful or rich. It's simply pure Riesling from a great terroir, and I adore the filigreed structure and intensity. Tasted in Wiesbaden in August 2021.

Busch's 2020 Marienburg GG Fahrlay Terrassen is fascinatingly pure and fresh on the nose, so it's hard to believe this is the terraced twin of the Fahrlay. On the palate, this is a fine and elegant, vital yet also lean Riesling that lacks the dimensions and thrill of the former vintages or even the finest 2020s from this biodynamic producer. The wine has salt and tannins and good tension yet not the complexity and intensity it has had in really great years. Tasted in Wiesbaden in August 2021.

Creamy, juicy and perhaps less precise and finessed than the other selections from the Marienburg, the Falkenlay is more baroque but also provided with a finely salty and grippy finish. The onion-colored, oxidative-styled 2014 Blanc de Noirs Spätburgunder Sekt Brut Nature opens with an intensely fruity yet fine bouquet with iodine notes of brown apples, sweet cherries, kumquat, redcurrant, yellow plums, brioche and ripe stone fruits. Full-bodied, round and creamy on the palate, this is an intense and textural yet also pure and refined Pinot sparkling wine with a vinous character and a long and fresh, finely structured mineral finish with lingering salinity. The perlage is highly delicate and interwoven with very fine tannins. An excellent Blanc de Noirs from slate. Tasted in July 2021.
